

AASG Serves

The Alaska Association of Student Governments promotes service by student councils in Alaska. . AASG has initiated the **Alaska Serves Project** Competition to promote community service and involvement in student councils across Alaska. Student governments wanting to take part in the competition must submit their project by April 4, 2012. The entry may be a project that the student council traditionally does, or a new idea.

Competing schools will develop a presentation (Essay, PowerPoint, Movie) that the Executive Board will review. The AASG Alaska Serves Committee will select no more than five finalists who will make a presentation to the General Assembly at the AASG 2012 Spring Conference in Kodiak High School. Each school at the conference will have one vote in the competition.

Schools should submit a project that not only displays productivity and results, but creativity and innovation. The Committee will judge projects on how many people were affected, creativity of the project, dedication from the student council, and how much work was put into the project.

The winning school will receive \$1,000 to be put straight into their student council treasury!

Schools must email the application and presentations by April 4th to esxt@live.com.

AASG Serves Project Presentation Rules

Presentations must last no longer than five minutes.
There is no limit for how many students may present.

Presentations must include:

- ☑ Description of the Project
- ☑ Target Population
- ☑ Final Results of the Project

If Spoken: If you plan to tell the delegation about your project with no visual aide:

- ☑ Written Speech must be submitted to the Executive Board by April 4th.

Video: If your school wants to make a video for a presentation:

- ☑ The video may last no more than five minutes and submitted by April 4th

PowerPoint: If you choose to use a PowerPoint, or other slideshow program:

☑ There is no limit for number of slides/animations, but the presentation can only be five minutes, and submitted to Exec Board by April 4th
