Be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments; that the graduating classes in the FNSBSD be given the opportunity to decorate their graduation caps for their graduation ceremony.

- 1. Whereas, Fairbanks North Star Borough School District policy currently prohibits students to decorate their graduation caps.
- **2.** Whereas, Kodiak, Soldotna, Matsu-Career and Tech, Delta-Junction, Wasilla, and Homer high schools have no such restrictions and are permitted to decorate their senior caps.
- **3. Whereas,** all seniors will be required to submit a drawing of their graduation cap decoration that will be re-checked upon entry to their graduation ceremony.
- **4.** Whereas, Capital high school in Montana has successfully been able to allow seniors to decorate their caps for graduation as long as they follow the guidelines provided.
- **5.** Whereas, decorating graduation caps gives seniors the opportunity to express themselves as individuals on a night that is supposed to celebrate their success.
- **6.** Whereas, all of Region 6 is in support of this resolution.
- 7. Whereas, North Pole High School class of 2017 and 2018 unanimously supports this resolution.
- 8. Therefore, be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that the Graduating classes of the FNSBSD be granted the opportunity to decorate their caps for graduation.
