

## Alaska Association of Student Government Resolution #10 Transparent Communication with ELL Programs Resolution Sitka High School Student Council April 20, 2024

## Be it Resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that:

- 1. Whereas, Exit requirements for ELL Access testing is a 4.5 composite proficiency score (for tier B or C grades 1-12);<sup>3</sup>
- 2. Whereas, English learners when exited from EL (English Learner) status will enter a monitoring status;<sup>3</sup>
- 3. Whereas, Monitoring status lasts up to four year;<sup>3</sup>
- 4. Whereas, Access test can take up to 265 minutes total per test;<sup>1</sup>
- 5. Whereas, Access testing occurs every second semester;<sup>3</sup>
- **6.** Whereas, Access occurs in grades 1-12;<sup>2</sup>
- 7. Whereas, The Alaska Board of Education adopted the WIDA English Language Development (ELD) Standards Frameworks Kindergarten 12th Grade 2020 Edition;<sup>2</sup>
- **8.** Whereas, Students in EL status will be assigned in classes with primarily English speaking peers;<sup>3</sup>
- **9.** Whereas, Students in EL status will be assigned in appropriate class;
- **10.** Whereas, When completing Access testing students are not informed of their progress or test scores;<sup>3</sup>
- 11. Whereas, Access testing occurs during a regular school day;<sup>3</sup>
- 12. Whereas, Students must fit a set of rules to be placed into EL status and Access testing;<sup>3</sup>

Therefore, be it resolved that the Alaska Association of Student Governments supports more policies to encourage transparent communication between the student and their parents with the student's ELL placement and status

**Action Statement:** if passed by the general assembly of AASG, this resolution will be sent to the Sitka School Board for consideration
