SEARHC hospital cafeteria for lunch option

Be it Resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that: Mt. Edgecumbe High School's administration will allow the dorm students to go to the SEARHC hospital cafeteria for lunch.

- 1. Whereas,** SEARHC stands for Southeast Alaska Regional Health Consortium;
- 2. Whereas,** some students skip meals and do not attend lunch because they do not want to eat the school food;
- 3. Whereas,** all town students are allowed to leave campus for lunch;
- 4. Whereas,** dorm students are not allowed to leave campus for lunch without a staff member or being checked out;
- 5. Whereas,** having more food options would overall increase our school's retention rates;
- 6. Whereas,** having the SEARHC cafeteria open for lunch provides more inclusive lunch options;
- 7. Whereas,** Mt. Edgecumbe cafeteria does not offer many vegetarian or vegan options;
- 8. Whereas,** teachers are no longer allowed to sell food to students who do not want to eat cafeteria food;
- 9. Whereas,** SEARHC staff has already said that their cafeteria can handle Mt. Edgecumbe's student body during lunch;
- 10. Whereas,** some staff members have expressed support for students going to lunch at the SEARHC cafeteria;
- 11. Whereas,** Mt. Edgecumbe High's General Assembly has already supported and passed the idea for attending the SEARHC cafeteria for lunch;

Therefore, be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments, supports Mt. Edgecumbe students going to the SEARHC cafeteria for lunch.
