**Changing the Region 2 Color to Purple**

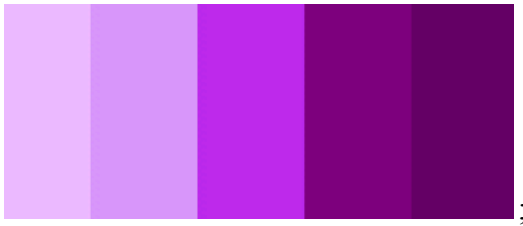
**Submitted by: Tri-Valley High School Student Council**

**Be it Resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that:**

1. **Whereas**, the current Region 2 colors are black and white;
2. **Whereas**, Region 1's color is green, Region 3's color is red, Region 4's color is blue, Region 5's color is pink, and Region 6's color is orange ;
3. **Whereas**, this means Region 2 is the only region without a bright color that represents them and therefore an outlier;
4. **Whereas**, region colors are meant to promote enthusiasm and spirit within the region;
5. **Whereas**, according to [colorpsychology.org](http://colorpsychology.org), "Black is also associated with depression because it can close in on us and take the positive aspects out of life, pushing us towards disappointment and the black or negative aspects out of life" ;

6. **Whereas**, according to colorpsychology.org, “purple adds dramatic flair to any palette”;
7. **Whereas**, the entire Tri-Valley Student Council unanimously supports this resolution;
8. **Whereas**, according to a survey sent out to all of Region 2 schools, 3 out of the 4 schools that responded prefer purple to be our region color;
9. **Whereas**, there are many shades of purple



10. **Whereas**, Tok, Tri-Valley, Anderson, and Susan B. English School unanimously support this resolution;

**Therefore, be it resolved that the Alaska Association of Student Governments** supports switching the official Region 2 AASG color to purple from black and white.


**Action Statement:** If passed by the General Assembly of AASG, Region 2 will change its colors from black and white to purple, effective for the next AASG conference.
