Be it Resolved by the Alaskan Association of Student Governments That The Fairbanks North Star Borough School District return the extension period to the end of the school day, and at least 45 minutes long.

- 1. Whereas, a majority of NPHS students agree this should be the case;
- 2. **Whereas,** if extension were at the end of the school day, students with jobs can be excused to leave early for work, while this is not possible with extension in the morning;
- 3. **Whereas,** an extension at the end of the school day would ensure students are more productive;
- 4. **Whereas,** a 45 minute extension would give clubs and activities more time to meet and act;
- 5. **Whereas,** a 45 minute extension would give students more time to get caught up on work;
- 6. **Whereas**, extension is defined as a study hall where students can make up work, do clubs and activities, and meet with teachers;

Therefore, be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments supports returning extension to the afternoon, and at least 45 minutes long in the Fairbanks North Star Borough School District.
