Proposal for Filipino Language Classes

- 1. Be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments;
- 2. Whereas, Filipinos account for half of the total Asian population since 2014.
- 3. **Whereas**, many young Filipinos cannot speak, write, read, or understand Filipino.
- 4. Whereas, Avant Assessment's Avant WorldSpeak program contains Filipino as a testing option. This would allow a Filipino class to qualify for credits and the Seal of Biliteracy which would increase opportunities for all students.
- 5. **Whereas**, many schools and universities have created these classes for students. For example, the Olympian High School in California and the University of Hawai'i Manoa both offer Filipino programs.
- 6. Whereas, over 107 languages are spoken in the Anchorage School District.
- 7. **Whereas**, there are currently 9 world languages taught throughout the Anchorage School District.
- 8. Whereas, the Anchorage School District is home to the top two diverse schools in the nation, East and Bartlett High School.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that a Tagalog class should be created in whichever school would like to pilot this program.
