

## Alaska Association of Student Governments Resolution #3

# **Expanding Career Credit Opportunities for Tri-Valley Students Submitted by: Tri-Valley Student Council**

#### 10/22/2021

### Be it Resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that:

- 1. Whereas, Tri-Valley School requires a career/technical credit in order to graduate<sup>1</sup>
- 2. **Whereas,** Tri-Valley School only offers accredited career credits through internship, building trades, and computer application
- 3. **Whereas,** Internship opportunities as organized by the school are limited to community resources
- 4. **Whereas,** community resources are limited to, internships as teaching assistants, coal mine or power plant employees, gas station workers, and limited online opportunities
- 5. Whereas, Tri-Valley School gives all high school students the opportunity to take online college classes<sup>1</sup>
- 6. Whereas, college classes are intended to prepare for careers
- 7. **Whereas,** students taking college classes do not earn career credits for their efforts in said class
- 8. **Whereas,** students taking college classes do earn college credit for their efforts in said class
- 9. Whereas, obtaining a higher degree typically leads to a higher salary<sup>2</sup>
- 10. Whereas, workers with higher education have lower unemployment rates<sup>2</sup>
- 11. **Whereas,** Prospective employers see people with higher education as less likely to need a significant amount of on the job training<sup>2</sup>

Therefore, be it resolved that the Alaska Association of Student Governments supports including college classes as a career credit option at Tri-Valley School

**Action Statement:** if passed by the General Assembly of AASG, The petition will be taken to Tri-Valley and DBSD (Denali Borough School District) administrative bodies for approval and administrative action
