## Be it resolved by the Eagle River High School Student Government that:

- 1. Whereas, it allows seniors to be creative and exercise individuality.
- 2. Whereas, it is a memorable object that seniors can personalize and use to keep high school memories.
- **3.** Whereas, an Eagle River High School staff member would approve the cap designs to make sure they're appropriate.
- **4.** Whereas, seniors are not required to decorate their caps but have the option to.
- 5. Whereas, Eagle River staff members can volunteer to approve cap designs if willing.
- **6.** Whereas, students will submit a copy of their design via Google Form for their cap.
- 7. Whereas, it can be a project for seniors to look forward to at the end of high school.
- 8. Whereas, seniors can represent their next steps such as colleges or sports on their cap.
- 9. Whereas, the deadline for seniors to turn in their cap design will be May 7th.
- **10.** Whereas, the design cannot be directly on the cap and must be on another material that can be removed if necessary.
- **11. Whereas,** the caps would be checked on the day of graduation to ensure that they are appropriate.
- 12. Whereas, student who don't follow the guidelines will have to remove their design.
- **13. Whereas,** this is an independent project and students who choose to participate must have their own supplies.
- **14. Whereas,** the Class of 2021 would start this resolution to be implemented starting in 2021 and remain for all following years.
- **15.** Whereas, a staff member will approve cap design for the 2021 school year.

- **16. Whereas,** the Eagle River High School dress code states that student are not allowed to wear items that display tobacco, alcohol, drugs, profanity, gang related signs, things that demean another person, spiked accessories, or bandanas.
- **17. Whereas,** the guidelines for the cap would directly coincide with the Eagle River dress code.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Alaska Association of Student Governments supports that Graduation Caps can be decorated by graduating seniors if approved by Eagle River High School faculty members.
