**Advanced Placement Opportunities**


**Be it Resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that:**

1. **Whereas**, survey data from Delta Junction High School indicates significant student interest in Advanced Placement (AP) courses;
2. **Whereas**, Delta Junction High School only offers dual enrollment classes that do not always transfer to other colleges;
3. **Whereas**, AP classes are more likely to transfer to a wider variety of colleges than dual enrollment classes, research.com claims AP classes are more versatile than dual enrollment classes, which are more widely accepted and convenient to take because they're offered through Edmentum which Delta Junction High School uses;<sup>2</sup>
4. **Whereas**, AP credit is awarded based on standardized national examinations, ensuring consistency across institutions;
5. **Whereas**, 85% of selective colleges and universities report that a student's AP experience favorably impacts admission decisions;<sup>1</sup>
6. **Whereas**, most four-year colleges and universities in the United States—and many institutions in more than 100 other countries—grant credit, advanced placement, or both for qualifying AP Exam scores;<sup>3</sup>
7. **Whereas**, every teacher who has a class that could be an AP class at Delta Junction High School is willing to do the training to teach the classes;
8. **Whereas**, research shows that students who earn an AP exam score of 3 or higher typically have a greater academic success in college, and higher graduation rates than their non-AP classmates;<sup>4</sup>
9. **Whereas**, offering AP classes would provide an alternative for students who excel academically and need to be challenged;

**Therefore, be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments** supports the implementation of Advanced Placement (AP) courses at Delta Junction High School;

**Action Statement:** If passed by the General Assembly of AASG, this resolution will be submitted to the Delta Junction High School administration and School Board for consideration and implementation.
