

Alaska Association of Student Government Resolution #7

Plan to Extend Passing Periods on Block Days at Eagle River High School Submitted by Eagle River High School October 13, 2023

Be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments that Eagle River High School adds two minutes to passing periods during block days, making them eight minutes long.

- 1. **Whereas,** the current passing periods at Eagle River High School (ERHS) are 6 minutes long throughout the entire week;
- 2. **Whereas,** ERHS follows a block schedule with only 4 classes on the days Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday;
- 3. Whereas, each block period is a duration of 82 minutes;
- 4. **Whereas,** students off time during the weekdays Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday consists of 4 passing periods and a 44-minute-long break for lunch;
- 5. **Whereas,** during the weekdays of Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, students are in class for about 5.5 hours vs. an off time of about 1 hour;
- 6. **Whereas,** according to South Dakota State University Extension, "[longer] [b]rain breaks have been proven to improve cognitive skills, increase brain activity and encourage social and emotional growth" (SDSU Extension);
- 7. **Whereas,** longer breaks in between classes greater the chances of a more focused student during class;
- 8. **Whereas,** most students' teachers require their students to use the restroom and go to their locker outside of class time;
- 9. **Whereas,** there are only three main locations to use restrooms in ERHS, so students experience long lines in the restroom during passing periods;
- 10. **Whereas,** students choose to either go to their lockers <u>or</u> use the restroom because they do not have time to do both before passing period is over;

- 11. **Whereas,** Chugiak High School, Service High School, and Dimond High School currently have passing periods that are 10 minutes long during block days;
- 12. **Whereas,** West Anchorage High School currently has passing periods that are 8 minutes long Monday-Friday;
- 13. **Whereas,** Bartlett High School currently has passing periods that are 7 minutes long Monday-Friday;
- 14. **Whereas,** South Anchorage High School currently has 6-minute passing periods on Monday & Friday and 8-minute passing periods on block days;
- 15. **Whereas,** with longer passing periods, students will be able to focus better on class, use the restroom, and access everything they need from their locker;

Therefore, be it resolved by the Alaska Association of Student Governments Eagle River High School adds two minutes to passing periods during block days, making them eight minutes long.

Action Statement: This resolution, if passed by the general assembly of AASG, will proceed to Eagle River High School Administration for further discussion and consideration.
